Fun for All Ages at Fremont Library in February

The Fremont Area District Library offers an exciting lineup of programs and events throughout February, offering something for everyone—from young children and teens to adults and families. Winter Reading for All Ages

The library's Winter Reading Challenge continues through February 27. Readers of all ages can sign up at the library to receive a reading log. Participants who complete the challenge by February 27 will earn a prize, and children and teens can also enter raffle drawings.
