The Fremont Area District Library is currently open for service (no appointment needed) and still offers curbside service. When you complete all 8 reading categories on your card, turn it in for a prize mug! The challenge will run through March 20th and you can sign up any time before then.

For teens, we have a winter reading challenge called Blizzard of Books. Like the adult winter reading challenge, teens can either sign up in the library or by calling to get their materials curbside. Each book read gives you a chance to win 1 of 2 local restaurant gift cards. If you finish 6 books and would like to keep going, you can get another reading kit for more entries.
