Fit for Life is a functional movement class designed to move the whole body through a series of seated and standing exercises that will increase strength, muscular endurance, balance and flexibility. Class is low impact and great for ALL levels of fitness who are interested in working on their health.

Harry Potter Day is on May 2nd, and to celebrate we will show **Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban** at 4:00 p.m. (PG; 142 min) People are encouraged to wear their Harry Potter costumes, and a small prize will be awarded to the best costume! Snacks provided.
