Fremont Library Offers Yummy Crafts, Superheroes, and More in November

The Fremont Area District Library is hosting several fun and educational programs in November for the whole family.

The Children's Department will have a yummy Harvest/Thanksgiving Craft on Saturday, November 10th from 10-11:30 a.m. that the kids can make and take home. Toddler Storytime, for babies and toddlers up to age 3, will be held on Wednesdays at 10:30 a.m., and Family Storytime for children birth to age 5 will be held on Thursdays at 10:30 a.m. We'll also be showing a new movie about a superhero family (Rated PG; 111 min) after school on Thursday, November 15th at 3:30 p.m. Refreshments will be served, and all are welcome. The "Intro to Computers" class will be taught on Thursday, November 8th from 2:00-4:00 p.m. This is a basic computer class for beginners. Participants will learn the parts of a computer and how they operate. Focus will be on using a mouse, as well as the basic operations of Windows; including opening, saving, printing and closing files. "Intro to Word" will be taught on Tuesday, November 13th from 2:00-4:00 p.m. Participants in this introduction to Microsoft Word will learn how to open, close and save files, cut & paste, use Spell Check, modify alignments, margins and fonts, and insert pictures.
